Privacy Statement

The Children's Protection Society (CPS) provides a range of community services, which form a continuum from prevention and early intervention to post-vention. These services include; therapeutic intervention, family support, education, training and fundraising.

In the provision of these services the CPS collects and holds personal information. As such we are bound to adhere to the following legislation.

- *Information Privacy Act 2000 (Victoria)*
- *Health Records Act 2001 (Victoria)*
- *Privacy Amendment (Private Sector) Act 2000 (National)*

The CPS values the importance of your privacy and is committed to protecting the information collected through our service provision, monitoring its use and disclosure and maintaining it accurately.

The CPS will only use the information collected for the purpose it was intended.

There are times when the CPS is obliged to provide information to other organisations including government departments. Our provision of this information will occur as outlined in our written policy and is limited to the purpose of collection of the information. At times, the law requires the disclosure of personal information.
